

Interactive Notebook Output Page Ideas

Output pages are designed to help you reflect and practice the learning from the input page. It should help deepen your understanding (and also help you realize areas you don't quite understand yet). You should complete an activity for every input page. I will often assign you a particular activity to complete, but if I don't here is a list of ideas to choose from.

- Venn Diagram or T-Chart to compare and contrast two vocabulary words /topics .
- Comic strip + a short explanation of how it relates to the topic
- Write a creative story over the topic .
- Choose 2 words – draw a picture, write the definition, use the word in a sentence, and give an example .
- Ask a question about the topic and research the answer .
- Make an acrostic poem using the topic or one of the vocabulary words
- Make a wanted poster or advertisement
- Write about a personal connection you have with the topic . How is the topic relevant to the world? Include a drawing or picture if you want!
- Work extra practice problems /activities from the textbook
- Create 3 riddles that are related to the topic and shows your knowledge of the topic
- Create 3 analogies . (Example : The cell membrane is like a gate because . . .)
- Draw 2 faces, each with a thought bubble for the topic . Your thought bubbles should explain and describe your understanding of the concept /topic .
- Write a summary about the topic using the following rule : Each written word is worth 10 cents . You must spend \$3 . 50– \$5 .
- Write 3 engaging newspaper headlines that would fit the topic . Explain what each headline has to do with the topic /unit .
- Create a flowchart or graphic organizer that uses at least 6 vocabulary words .
- Create a cheer or song showing your understanding of the information . You can use it to study!
